

National Chung Hsing University Guidelines for Recognition of Outstanding Teacher in General Education

- Article 1 This Guideline is established to recognize outstanding teaching in general education and encourage excellent full-time and adjunct teachers to join general education so as to promote the teaching quality of general education courses.
- Article 2 Outstanding teachers in General Education shall meet the following qualifications:
1. must have taught three or more general education courses cumulated in the past three academic years, which reached six credits or more with the addition of personal teaching credits.
 2. must have maintained a satisfaction level of top 1/3 on average in general education courses in the past three academic years.
 3. must have taught in general education courses in which the average scores are below average in the University's general education courses in the past three academic years.
- Article 3 Language Division courses and common general education courses (Humanitarian Division, Social Science Division, Life Science Division) are all calculated in accordance with the aforementioned qualifications.
- Article 4 Recognition for outstanding teachers are hosted once a year, any candidates that qualify for the aforementioned qualifications are awarded with a certificate.
- Article 5 Cannot be a previous recipient of this award.
- Article 6 In the condition that the qualified Full-time teacher is also qualified for nomination for "National Outstanding Teacher in General Education" by the Ministry of Education, the General Education Centre may make the proposal for General Education Executive Committee to make the referral.
- Article 7 Any unspecified areas in the Guideline is governed by and shall be construed in all respects in accordance with the laws and regulations of the University.
- Article 8 This Guideline is established and executed after the approval of General Education Executive Committee and Administrative Affairs Meeting; any amendments made hereafter shall be the same.
