NCHU Regulations for the Establishment of the General Education Advisory Committee

Enacted in the 76th Academic Affairs Meeting on Oct. 31st, 2018

- Article 1 To promote general education, the University has established the National Chung Hsing University Regulations for the Establishment of the General Education Advisory Committee (hereafter referred to as the Committee) in accordance with the school's organizational regulations.
- Article 2 The responsibilities of this committee are as follows:
 - 1.Discuss the concepts and goals of general education courses.
 - 2.Discuss major policies, institutional creation, and reforms in general education.
 - 3. Planning the development direction of general education courses.
 - 4. Discuss other major issues related to general education.
- Article 3 The committee is convened by a Vice President appointed by the President, and the members of the committee are as follows:
 - 1.Ex-officlo members: the Vice President, the Vice President for Academic Affairs, the deans of each college, the Chief Director of the General Education Center, and the president of the student council.
 - 2.Appointment of committee members: The president may recruit one or two relevant scholars or experts to serve.

When a committee member is unable to attend due to certain reasons, they may appoint a deputy to attend and exercise their rights at the meeting. All other members should attend the meeting in person.

- Article 4 The committee members serve a one-year term and can be re-elected. If a committee member leaves their post during their term, the successor's term will be counted together with the term of the original member.
- Article 5 This committee meets at least once every academic year, with the Vice President as the chair. When the Vice President is unable to attend the meeting for some reason, they may designate a deputy to act as the chair.
- Article 6 For any matters not mentioned herein, please refer to related NCHU regulations.
- Article 7 These Regulations and any amendments hereto shall be approved in Academic Affairs Meetings before taking effect.
