For the 2025–2026 Academic Year (Academic Year 114):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Students taking courses worth more than 9 credits (excluding PE and Teacher Education Program credits) will be charged full tuition and miscellaneous fees according to their respective college. Students taking courses worth 9 credits or fewer (excluding PE and Teacher Education Program credits) will be charged credit fees only, based on the credit rate for continuing education undergraduate programs. <p>ii. Starting from the 2026–2027 Academic Year (Academic Year 115):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Students taking courses worth 10 credits or more (excluding PE and Teacher Education Program credits) will be charged full tuition and miscellaneous fees according to their respective college. Students taking courses worth fewer than 10 credits (excluding PE and Education credits) will be charged credit fees based on the continuing education undergraduate rate, and miscellaneous fees will be calculated as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Taking courses worth 0 to 3 credits ($0 \leq \text{credits} \leq 3$): pay (3/10) of the college's miscellaneous fees. (2) Taking courses worth more than 3 but fewer than 10 credits ($3 < \text{credits} < 10$): pay (credits/10) of the college's miscellaneous fees. | | | | | |

Note 2: Language lab fee: Mandatory in every semester during first year of enrolment. Department of Foreign Language students NT\$780, other department students NT\$650 per semester.

Note 3: Computer facilities and Internet fees: Students enrolled after 2016 have to pay a mandatory computer facilities and Internet fees of NT\$300 per semester.

Note 4: Teacher education program credit fees are charged additionally, rate per credit follows the same standard of credit rate as continuous education for undergraduate programs.
