Article1	Students in undergraduate programs or extension education programs who meet one
	of the following criteria may waive the freshman English courses offered by NCHU:
	a. Students who meet the English proficiency criteria
	1.TOEFL IBT 78 points and above
	2.IELTS level 6 and above
	3.Cambridge Certificate of English FCE and above
	4.TOIC 785 and above
	5."General English Proficiency test" medium high and above.
	b. Students who in the past 3 years had studied in an English-speaking country
	for two years or more. The said students shall submit application accompanied
	by relevant documents to the department offering the English courses for review and approval.
Article2	Students who are in undergraduate programs and extension education programs
	and meet the criteria specified in Article 1 shall submit application for waiving
	freshman English courses to the Language Center before the course
	adding/dropping deadline in the first year of their study. Late applications will not
	be accepted.

Article3 These regulations and any amendments hereto shall be implemented after being reviewed at the school's Academic Affairs Meeting and approved by the President of NCHU.
