Enacted in the 53rd Academic Affairs Meeting on Apr. 10th, 2007 Enacted in the 54th Academic Affairs Meeting on Oct. 25th, 2007

- Article 1 The University establishes this guideline to promote interdisciplinary courses of all colleges, departments and institutes, and give students more opportunities to learn things in different fields to help them pursue higher degrees or have better career development.
- Article 2 Each academic department and research institute may establish degree programs of interdisciplinary courses according to their academic and research development.
- Article 3 Degree programs of the University shall take in students outside and inside of the University. All teaching and research units shall submit a detailed proposal and establish regulations for degree programs when they want to establish degree programs. The proposals shall be discussed and approved according to "National Chung Hsing University Regulations for the Approval of the Addition and Adjustment of Research Unites" by all participating units and colleges. After the approval, the proposals shall and any amendments hereto shall be approved in Research and Development meeting and the University Meeting, and be submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval before being publicly announced and taking effect. Degree programs may open courses before their curriculum planning are approved by the Curriculum Committee and the Academic Affairs Meeting of the University.
- Article 4 Following items shall be written in the program:
 - I. Chinese and English name of the program.
 - II. Purpose of the program.
 - III. Chinese and English name of the referred degree.
 - IV. Participating academic department and research institute.
 - V. Lecturers and professors of this program.
 - VI. Course planning (including the name of the subject, credit hours, course opening academic department, graduation requirement).
 - VII. Budget resource.
 - VIII. Arrangement of source (including equipment for teaching and research).
 - IX. Administrative management (administrative, mentor arrangement and student counseling).
 - X. Source and number of recruitment.
 - XI. The entry requirements, application requirements and the approval procedures of recruitment outside of the University.
 - XII. Other special requirements.
- Article 5 The recruitment number of degree program shall be included in the total recruitment of the University. The maximum recruitment number is 60 for bachelor

- program, 30 for master's program and in-service master's program, 15 for doctoral program.
- Article 6 The minimum graduation credit and other related things shall follow the rules of University Act and its enforcement rules, Degree Conferral Law and its enforcement rules, and the degree related regulations of the University.
- Article 7 When students apply to transfer to, minor or major in degree programs, procedures shall follow the University regulations and related rules.
- Article 8 Students may waive the credit hours before applying for the degree program. Subjects and credit hours may be waived according to the Course Credit Waiver Regulations of Chung Hsing University and may not need to take the course again.
- Article 9 The minimum and maximum year of study shall follow the related rules of the University regulations.
- Article 10 The approval for graduation requirements and conferral of degrees for students who complete all courses shall follow the regulations in the University Act and its enforcement rules, Degree Conferral Law and its enforcement rules, and other related rules of the University.
- Article 11 Students who want to terminate their degrees shall submit an explanation letter one academic year before the termination to related academic departments to sign. The termination shall be passed by the research and development meeting and University Affairs meeting, and be approved by the Ministry of Education before publicly announced and taking effect.
- Article 12 These regulation and any amendments hereto shall be approved in Department Faculty Meetings, and publicly announced before taking effect.
