National Chung Hsing University Standards for EMI Level Certification

Enacted in the $84^{\mbox{\tiny th}}$ Academic Affairs Meeting on Nov. $10^{\mbox{\tiny th}},\ 2022$

- Article 1 The standards herein have been formulated by the National Chung Hsing University (hereinafter referred to as NCHU) to encourage students to enroll in EMI (English as a Medium of Instruction) courses and learn professional subjects in English as this will strengthen English levels and global mobility in students.
- Article 2 "EMI Level" herein is a certification recognizing the number of EMI credits students have acquired before graduation.
- Article 3 Standards for EMI level certification for undergraduate programs (including extension education undergraduate programs), master's programs (including in-service master's programs & Industrial Research and Development master's programs), and doctoral programs are defined below in compliance with the Standards for EMI Level Certification set forth in the Program on Bilingual Education for Students in College and minimum credit requirements for graduation (excluding language literacy credits for undergraduate programs and thesis credits for master's or doctoral programs):
