

## General Education Center 【Cross-Field Project】 Instructions

### 1. Purpose of the Activity:

In order to cultivate students' problem-solving skills and establish an active learning attitude, General Education Center plans the "Cross-Field Project" course. Students propose study plans, not limited to professional academic fields. Life experiences can also be planned such as self-guided travel, study tours, grand tours, and public welfare services. They can inspire students' creativity and expand their life horizons.

### 2. Applicant Qualifications:

It is limited to undergraduate students of our school. Individual application is the principle. If the project content should be completed by a group, you can apply as a group and a group leader must be designated to be responsible for liaison with the General Education Center.

### 3. Activity Schedule:

There is no limit to the practice schedule and venue. Please plan it yourself. It can be completed in several times or across semesters.

### 4. Application Deadline: Accepted at any time.

### 5. How to apply:

Send the electronic file of the application form to [sch53@nchu.edu.tw](mailto:sch53@nchu.edu.tw). Please indicate "Application for Cross-Field Project - name and student number" in the subject line. The review results will be notified by e-mail within one week. Please go to the General Education Center website "Forms / For Students" section to download the application form.

### 7. Reports:

The learning plan should be recorded in detail and the electronic reports should be submitted within one month after completion:

- (1) The report video is 3 to 5 minutes long and must be accompanied by background music and subtitles or photo captions.
- (2) Written report of 3000 words includes motivation or purpose, plan overview, activity process, execution results, how to solve difficulties encountered, reflection (at least 1000 words, please focus on self-growth before and after the activity, or the mutual help of crews) and attach at least 10 photos. Please arrange the layout appropriately.
- (3) If it is a joint written report by a group, each member must write 1000 words of reflection (a total of 3000 words for 1 person, 4000 words for 2 people, and 5000 words for 3 people).

8. Credits Awarded:

- (1) After the reports are reviewed and approved by the General Education Center, each student will be awarded 1 credit of "Cross-Field Project (I)" or "Cross-Field Project (II)", which can be counted as graduation credits in the General Education Integrated Domains. Passing grades will be marked as "P" and is not included in the semester average.
- (2) For those who complete the study plan and submit the reports before the 14th week of the semester, the credits will be recorded in the current semester; for those who complete the study plan after that, the credits will be recorded in the next semester.
- (3) Those whose tuition is calculated based on the number of course credits (such as: Extension Education Undergraduate Program, delayed graduation...) must pay the credit fee to receive 1 credit of " Cross-Field Project ".
