國立中與大學雙語教學推動資源中心 雙語學生自主學習社群實施計畫

一、依據

教育部大專校院學生雙語化學習計畫。

二、目的

為鼓勵本地生與外籍生間自主合作學習與學業交流,期以本計畫推動學生組成學習社群,學習將英語技巧活用於專業領域,並透過討論與分享,進以深化學生獨立思考能力及拓展多元文化視野。

三、計畫內容

- (一)申請對象:本校在校生,每名學生限參加一組社群計畫。
- (二)申請資格:每一社群由2至4名學生組成(至少1名外籍生),並推舉1名本地生擔任社 群召集人,以負責提送申請與擔任聯繫窗口。
- (三)申請期程:即日起至規定期限內至雙語教學推動資源中心(以下簡稱本中心)提出申請。
- (四)審核原則:請於申請期程內繳齊申請資料,內容不全或格式不符者,恕不予受理,審核結果將公布於本中心網頁及通知申請者。
- (五)執行要項及相關規範:

- 2. 本計畫經費來源為中央補助款項,故陸生(不含港澳生)不得申請此計畫。
- 3. 已獲教育部或校內外補助者,不得重複申請本計畫補助。若經發現,本中心將終止(或 追回)補助經費,不得異議。
- 4. 原有獎助學金者須事先確認原獎助學金領取資格及限制;若不得領取額外獎助學金,仍 可參與但不得領取助學金。如經發現,本中心將終止(或追回)補助經費,不得異議。

Bilingual Self-directed Learning Community Program

(Article 1)

This plan is based on the Program on Bilingual Education for Students in College, BEST.

[Article 2] Purpose

This plan aims to foster student learning communities to encourage collaboration and academic exchange between local and international students. It promotes the practical use of English skills in professional fields, encourages discussion and sharing, and enhances students' independent thinking abilities while broadening their multicultural perspectives.

[Article 3] Implementation

- 1. Object: Current students of NCHU. Each student can only participate in one learning community.
- 2. Requirements: Each learning community must consist of 2 to 4 students (at least one must be an international student). One local student must be designated as the community leader, responsible for submitting applications and serving as the main contact.
- 3. Application Deadline: Applications must be submitted within the specified period to the Bilingual Education Resource Center (referred to as "the Center").
- 4. Review Criteria: Applications must be complete and submitted on time. Incomplete or incorrectly formatted applications will not be processed. Approved applications will be announced on the Center's website, and applicants will be notified.
- 5. Implementation Guidelines & Regulations:
 - (1) Learning Community Discussion Sessions
 - Topic Categories (Please select one category; once selected, no changes will be permitted):

Item	Description
II Seminar I	Discussions or literature reviews conducted in English for research or experimental purposes.
EMIT / ESAP Study	To enhance professional learning in EMI (English as Medium of Instruction) courses/ESAP (English for Specific Academic Purposes) courses through joint discussions, review of assigned readings, or extended reading materials.
II I earning Review	Sharing learning experiences from courses using English as the primary medium.
International Cultural Exchange	Sharing cultural topics (films, literary works, etc.), different countries' histories, language cultures, etiquette, and cultural differences, life experiences, or discussions.

• Implementation Guidelines:

Language Requirements	Primary communication must be in English.	
Time and Frequency	 Must be scheduled outside regular class hours, typically 50 minutes per session. Any changes must be notified to the Center in advance; retroactive notifications will not be counted. Must hold 4 sessions, maximum one session per day. 	
Total Attendance Rate Must reach 75% or above of community members.		

(2) English Self-Learning: Each member must use digital English learning resources/take English proficiency tests as follows:

Calculation Method 1. MyET self-learning software: 30 minutes counts as 1 session (incomplete not counted); maximum 2 sessions per day. 2. EnglishScore proficiency test: Each completed score counts as 1 session cannot be repeated, and the Center will issue certificates at the end of ser achieving B1 or above (highest score counted).		
Note: An extra session is counted daily for learning or testing at the English Self-Learning and Testing Center (Wannian Building Room 206).

(4) The project implementation period and submission deadlines will be announced on the Center's website. Those who fail to follow the regulations, submit required materials, or have missing documents will be considered as forfeiting their subsidy.

[Article 4] Funding Principles and Standards

- 1. Subsidy Principles:
 - (1) Maximum student stipend of 7,000 NTD per student and issuance of participation certificate.
 - (2) The above stipend is based on project completion (discussion session frequency and attendance rate, English self-learning frequency) and submission of result items as evaluation criteria (see Attachment 5); incomplete requirements will result in a proportional reduction of the stipend.
- 2. Other Important Notes
 - (1) This project depends on annual budget planning; applications will close when the current year's budget is exhausted.
 - (2) As this project is funded by central government subsidies, Mainland Chinese students (excluding Hong Kong and Macau students) are not eligible to apply.
 - (3) Those who have received Ministry of Education or other internal/external subsidies cannot apply for this project subsidy. If discovered, the Center will terminate (or recover) the subsidy without dispute.
 - (4) Those with existing scholarships must verify their eligibility and restrictions beforehand; if not eligible for additional scholarships, they may participate but cannot receive the stipend. If discovered, the Center will terminate (or recover) the subsidy without dispute.

[Article 5] Project Evaluation

Performance in this project will serve as an important reference for future application reviews.
